

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS 2021 AMA SPEEDWAY NATIONAL UNDER 21 CHAMPIONSHIP & YOUTH LONG TRACK NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Name of Event: 2021 AMA Speedway National Under Championship, AMA Youth 250cc Speedway Long Track National Championship, AMA 150cc Mini Speedway Long Track National Championship.

Sanction: The series is sanctioned by the American Motorcyclist Association.

Rules and governance: 2021 AMA Racing Rulebook and these Supplementary Regulations govern the competition. The AMA reserves the right to modify and reissue these Supplementary Regulations, as necessary.

Purse: U21 Championship Purse - \$2,000

Officials: Each event will run according to the 2021 AMA Racing rulebook and these Supplemental Regulations. The overall running of the meeting and decisions regarding such matters as postponement, or any matter not covered in writing will be decided on the day between the event advisory group consisting of the promoter or his named clerk of the course, AMA representative and referee. The Event Referee is the sole person responsible for receiving and deciding on all protests.

Fork Covers: Riders retain exclusive right to advertising on their machines, including the fork covers.

Fuel: Fuel will be provided.

Tires: Any approved speedway tire in 2021 AMA rulebook or subsequently issued amendment (as the Anlas) is allowed

Substance Abuse Policy: Compliance with the AMA's Substance Abuse Policy is an essential precondition to competition. Random tests for prohibited substances may be conducted at the discretion of AMA Racing.

Entered Riders - Starting positions and draw conducted by the AMA.

150cc Mini Will not run unless a minimum of four entries are received 48 hours or more before the event.

Entry Fees and Pit Gate Fees: Riders pay standard track fees \$45

Under 21

Competition for individual riders: twelve riders plus Track Reserves as available will compete in each meeting.

The meeting will be composed of fourteen heats. Each rider races in four heats. Riders placed 1st and 2nd will go straight to the Main Event. Riders in positions 3-6 will go to a Semi Final with 1st and 2nd qualifying for the Main Event.

All heats will be run with a maximum of four riders over 4 laps.

Riders will be awarded race points according to their finish position in each race: 3 points for first place, 2 points for second place, 1 point for third place and 0 point for fourth place.

Final positions will be determined by finishing positions in Main / Semi / Heat points

All heats have pre-fixed starting positions in accordance with the Race Format. Points scored in heats give gate preference for semi-final. Main Event has top two scorers from heat with first gate choices, then 1st and 2nd in semifinal with next choice in that order.

If the event is shortened due to weather or some other situation, the result shall be declared if the event has run beyond 3 rounds (9 heats). If the event is abandoned mid-round the results will go back to the last completed round.

If the event is abandoned before the completion of Round 3 it shall be deemed void and be restaged at a date TBD.

Ties: After the completion of Heat 12.

When establishing the order between the riders in the list of Intermediate Classification at the conclusion of Heat 12 any ties outside of for positions 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be solved as follows:

a) Precedence will be given to the riders (tied on race points) having the greatest number of 1sts, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th placings (a "0" for last placing is better than being disqualified for whatever reason).

b) If the tie persists and involves only 2 riders, precedence will be given to the better-placed rider in the heat or heats where the 2 riders met.

c) If the tie persists and involves more than two riders, it shall be checked whether there is a possibility to determine a proper precedence (e.g., 3 riders tied on points: A, B, C)

- * Rider A has beaten rider B
- * Rider A has beaten rider C
- * Rider B has beaten rider C

Then the precedence will be best position for rider A, then rider B and then rider C.

An unbreakable tie for 2nd or 6th after heat twelve will be determined by run off Ties that cannot be broken on an abandoned meeting will be considered a shared finishing position with the riders sharing the prize money for the shared positions.

Race Format 250cc Long Track

Event shall consist of 5 Main Events featuring four of the five entries in each race. Points score 3,2,1,0. Points are added up over all five events to decide the finishing order. A tie for first place is decided by run off. All other ties are settled by countback rules per above tie breaker rules for U21. If a tie cannot be broken by above countback, the last time the riders met on track will determine. If the event is not completed results can be declared if each rider has completed three rounds. Points will go back in this circumstance to the last fully completed round (i.e., all riders completed third or fourth ride).
